



Fred Meijer White Pine Trail State Park Stanwood to Reed City

The 21.5-mile stretch from Stanwood to Reed City is now completely paved, except a 3.5-mile section south of Big Rapids pending culvert repairs and replacement. Expect a possible detour. Take the loop through the Big Rapids Riverwalk (see next page) to ride along the river's edge.

The ride from Big Rapids to Reed City and back is a popular day trip. Cross a towering bridge over the Muskegon River as the trail heads north to the quaint hamlet of Paris, home of Paris County Park and the historic Paris Fish Hatchery. You must purchase a day pass to park at Paris County Park. Camping and restrooms are available at the park.

The trail climbs a slight grade through white pine forest and alfalfa fields on its way to Reed City and the beautiful Reed City Depot at the junction of the Pere Marquette State Trail. The Depot offers tourist information, restrooms and a picnic pavilion near food stores and several restaurants in Reed City's downtown shopping district.
